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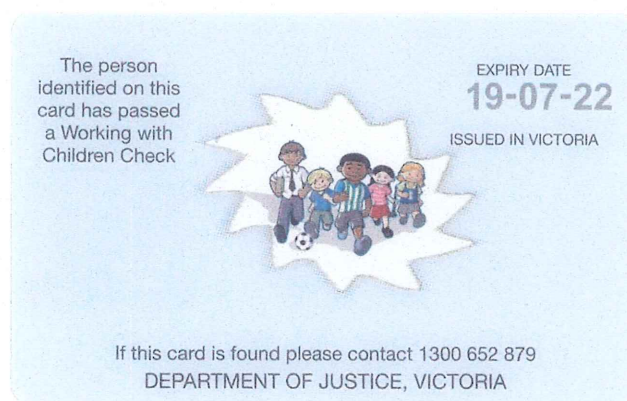
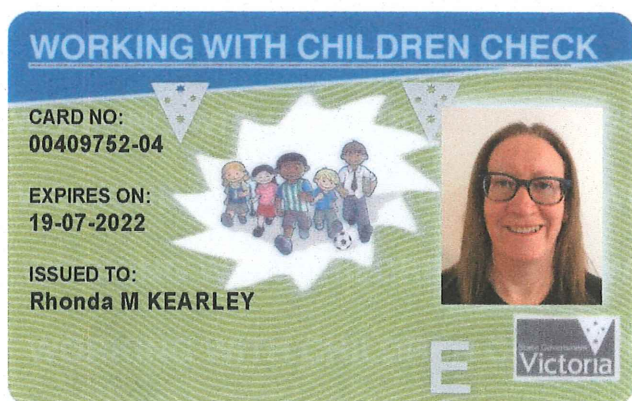

- Respect Assessment Notice Holders' confidentiality and privacy.
- Regularly check the status of employees' or volunteers' WWC Checks.
- Ensure Assessment Notice holders notify the Department of Justice of changes to their contact details.
- Ensure that all of your employees and/or volunteers, who are engaged in child-related work, have listed your organisation.
